

HOUSING

- Live with CET peers & local Czech students
- 2-6 people/apartment

- WiFi access, A/C, linens, basic furnishing, kitchenware

LOCAL ROOMMATES

- You share an apartment with other CET students and possibly a Czech roommate. You are close to cafés, public transportation, downtown, and parks—after all, Prague was recently named the greenest city in the world.
- Czech roommates help you get to know the real Prague. They might take you for a hike in the countryside, show you how to cook Czech food, or take you to their favorite cafés in the city.

This program is unique for its pairing of students with individual mentors that supervise, guide, and teach each artist throughout the creation of their final work. Nowhere in the US can you find this kind of one-to-one attention and focus on the individual student.

- Take a CET-sponsored excursion to Berlin. Go on a backlot studio tour at Babelsberg Studio. Attend a screening and discussion with young German filmmakers. Explore Berlin's historic sites on your own. Later in the term, attend a film festival in the Czech Republic.
- Get outside of Prague with CET and explore the Czech Republic. Start the term in Český Krumlov with your CET peers then opt into other excursions to nearby Czech towns like Kutná Hora, Jáchymov, and Plzeň.


CET SCHOLARSHIPS
