Why Go for a Gap?



CET Gap Core Course


No matter which CET Gap program you choose, you will be enrolled in the Gap Core Course. This class will connect you to other CET Gap students around the world and cover topics unique to the gap experience. You will meet virtually once a week to reflect and explore global topics and issues, your experience in your host country, academic work, and your plans for your college experience. This not-for-credit course is taught in English and seeks to help you make the most of your time abroad, support and suppliment your academic growth, connect you with your peers around the world, and prepare you for future success both in and out of the classroom.

Key Program Elements

- ➤ Immersive Program Design. All Gap at CET programs provide a well-rounded experience designed to immerse you in the local culture and fulfill your needs as a gap student.
- > City as Your Classroom. Whether in-person or virtual, Gap at CET programs utilize the local environment to help you engage beyond the CET community. You might interview locals, visit companies and organizations, or spend your class sessions in galleries and museums.
- Passionate, Dedicated Instructors. CET faculty are passionate about supporting you during your gap education. Feeling a little behind? Stuck on a tricky grammar pattern? You are welcome and encouraged to reach out to your teachers for help, advice, and even learning accommodations.

Help Every Step of the Way



GET STARTED

Eligibility

To be eligible for a Gap at CET program, you:

- > Must have a high school diploma or the equivalent
- Must be over the age of 18 at time of program participation (or earlier if necessary for visa application)
- > Cannot be currently enrolled at a college or university
- ➤ Have a cumulative high school grade point average of 3.0 or higher.*

*Is your GPA lower than 3.0? Get in touch! We make exceptions to this criteria on a case-by-case basis.

How to Apply

- 2. Complete the application requirements including:
 - a. Application Form
 - b. Teacher Recommendation
 - c. Official Transcript

What's Included

All CET Gap programs include tuition, student support, and course materials. CET in-person Gap programs also include housing, comprehensive insurance, staff support, visa assistance, and activities and excursions.

Financial Assistance

CET is committed to increasing access to gap programs for all students. CET has a financial assistance pool for students who demonstrate family financial need. Award amounts usually range from \$250 to \$2,000. You have access to the application when you begin a program application on the CET website.
