


CET also works with Dickinson staff to operate our France and Spain programs at Dickinson centers in Toulouse and Málaga.

The Dickinson-CET Global Leaders Scholarship is a **four-year**, **full-tuition scholarship** awarded annually to a college-bound student who shows interest in global issues and has participated in CET high school programs for which Dickinson grants course credit.

Eligibility

To be eligible for a Summer Pre-College Global Perspective program, you must:

- ➤ Be between the ages of 15 and 18 at the program start date 16 for CET Global Perspectives: Spain and 15-19 for CET
- Global Perspectives: Japan)
 Be a rising sophomore, junior, or senior in high school, or a recent graduate, but not yet enrolled in a college or
- university degree program Generally, competitive applicants have a GPA of 3.0 or higher, however admissions decisions are made on a caseby-case basis.



HOUSING & MEALS

- > Live in a homestay with hosts vetted and trained by CET. Make your way to class as the locals do on the train.
- > Osaka is called "the nation's kitchen," and you will understand why by the end of the summer. Enjoy home-cooked meals at your homestay and then find your favorite snacks at the local konbini (convenience store).
